


Having problems logging into your Gmail account?

Your login screen should appear something like this if you have a Gmail account.

Example


Username: centrallibraryrocks

OR

Username: centrallibraryrocks@gmail.com

With the username and password box filled in –you should be able to access your account.

If for some reason you either forgot your password, username, or mistyped something your screen will appear as so:
